2011 Auction Protocol



Checking-In

Doors open and registration begins at 5:00 pm. When you check in, please present your credit card to have it swiped into the system. Your card number will be linked with your bid number and will be activated and associated with your winning bids. If you do not place or win any bids, your card number will not be activated. All card numbers will be erased at the end of the evening. We will print a receipt and have it ready for you at the end of the night.

Silent Auction

Silent auction items are displayed around the room. To place a bid, write your bid number and sign the bid sheet next to the item. To be valid, bids must be legible and comply with the minimum bid and minimum raise for each item. The winning bid is the last (highest) valid bid entered prior to closing. Closing times are indicated in the Schedule of Events. Placing a bid constitutes a legal contract to purchase at the price stated if your bid is the winning bid. Some items are available for “buy it now” prices. You immediately win the item by placing your bid number on the “buy it now” line. **DO NOT REMOVE THE BID SHEETS** from the tables. Please respect the volunteer Table Closers by letting them remove the bid sheets in a timely manner. The Auction team reserves the right to extend the Silent Auction or move items to the Live Auction, should bids warrant.

Live Auction

The live auction begins after dinner, around 8:30 pm. When bidding, hold up your bid number toward the auctioneer. A bid acknowledged by the auctioneer is a legal contract to purchase the item. When bidding on an item as a group, please designate one person to place the combined bid. If you win a live auction item, a runner will come to your table and ask you to sign the bid sheet for the bid amount. If splitting payment, enter everyone’s bid numbers, names and amounts.

We accept checks (payable to MDES PFC), Master Card, Visa, American Express, and Diners Club. The PFC incurs a processing fee for credit card purchases. If you swiped your card but would rather pay by check, visit the check-out table and we will make the adjustment.

Our check-out team will help you find your items before you leave the event. It is your responsibility as a purchaser to remove your winning items by the end of the auction.

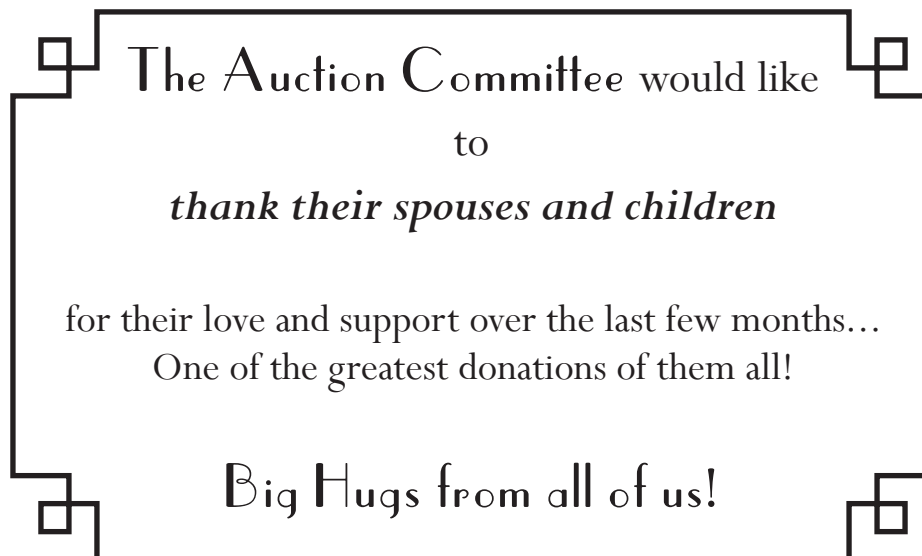

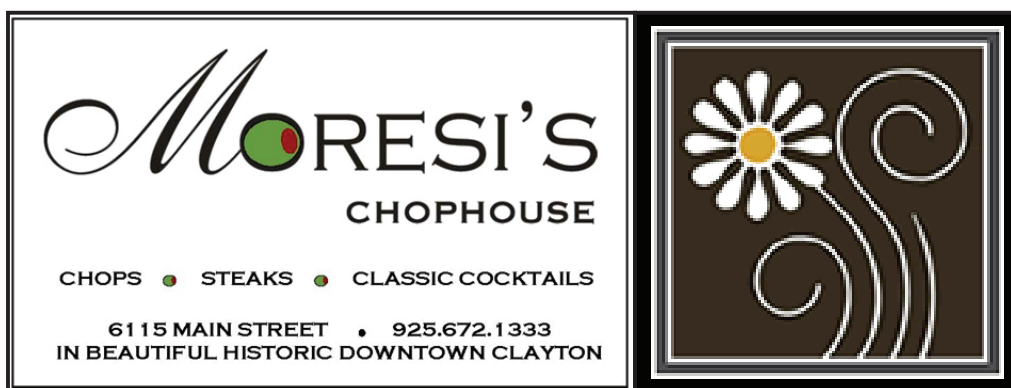
